

**RESOLUTION
R 253 - 10/11**

A RESOLUTION TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

*Sanitary Sewer 15-inch Main Collector Pipe Line that runs behind
the old Wal-Mart complex southward towards Second Avenue*

WHEREAS, according to an onsite evaluation by the Wastewater Superintendent of Selma Waterworks and the professional assessment of Hogg Engineering Corporation, it appears to be a major collapse of and/or blockage in the Sanitary Sewer main collector pipe line that runs behind the old Wal-Mart complex southward towards Second Avenue which is apart of the infrastructure that carries all of the sewage from north of Highland Avenue and West of Broad Street, requiring the immediate replacement thereof; *and*

WHEREAS, in the event of an imminent situation effecting public health, safety and/or convenience, the governing body may declare an emergency, via resolution, signifying that the situation requires immediate attention; *and*

WHEREAS, after considering the circumstances and professional opinions of this matter along with reviewing the information provided with due diligence, the Selma City Council assents that an emergency does exist; *and*

WHEREAS, Hogg Engineering Corporation estimates that it will cost approximately \$116,840 to replace the section of the main collector pipe in question, to be encumbered against a combination of 2010 Bond Fund and Oil Lease monies. Professional Engineering and Inspection fees in the amount of \$13,440 to be funded by Professional Services line item (Account Reference: 1.6000.100-10).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Selma, Alabama as follows:

That the collapse of and/or blockage in the Sanitary Sewer main collector pipe line that runs behind the old Wal-Mart complex southward towards Second Avenue has an imminent effect on public health, safety and/or convenience and is hereby declared an emergency;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor is hereby authorized to proceed with the replacement of the sanitary sewer 15-inch main collector pipe in question, including entering into a contract with Hogg Engineering Corporation for Professional Engineering and Inspection services.


